### What Happens Next?

After this form has been submitted, it is reviewed by members of the JLB Member Impact Team, and all women who agree with the commitments set forth within this form are invited to attend a mandatory **JLB Provisional Orientation** on Tuesday February 8<sup>th</sup>, with a 530pm social and 6pm meeting start time at the Junior League of Boise office. *If you are unable to make this meeting, it is important to make alternate arrangements with someone on the Member Impact Team.*

This form and dues or dues down payment have a deadline of Wednesday, February 15<sup>th</sup>. This form can be mailed to our League office or emailed to *office@jlboise.com*. Dues checks or forms can be mailed in or called into the League office at 208-424-5011 between 9-1 on Monday, Tuesday, or Thursday.

Then, you will be invited to monthly Provisional Member trainings, where you will learn leadership training, League history and structure, and begin your Provisional Class Project.

### 2016-17 Junior League of Boise Provisional Program Requirements

There will be two provisional classes a year in the Fall and Spring. Each provisional member would have the following requirements to complete the provisional program:

1. Attend an orientation to learn about the Junior League of Boise. If unable to attend group class, alternative arrangements may be made with a member of the Member Impact Team.
2. Attend at least one General Membership Meeting (GMM) during the provisional class. At this meeting, the provisionals would be introduced to the League membership. The provisional members are strongly encouraged to attend all GMMs.
3. Plan and carry out a Provisional Project, perhaps with assistance from the Community Impact Team and Member Impact Team.
4. Assist Development Team in planning a Junior League of Boise fundraiser, as requested. It is likely the Fall class assist with the Evening in Idaho fundraiser preparation. It is likely the Spring class assist with the Evening in Idaho or fall fundraiser, depending on greater need.
5. Organize and attend a social event to celebrate completing the provisional program.

6. Attend the May event, where provisionals will be voted active members of the Junior League of Boise.
7. Submit a headshot (professional or non-professional) to the Junior League Office ([office@jlboise.com](mailto:office@jlboise.com)) to be published in the Annual Manual.
8. Pay \$143.00 in provisional dues.

Provisional members will be voted in active status each May, regardless of whether they were part of the Fall or Spring class. Graduating Fall class women would be placed on a committee in January, even though they are not yet active members. The Fall class will pay provisional dues in September, and active dues for the next year in March. The Spring class will pay provisional dues in January and active dues for the next year in May.
